



Mr. Toast Man: Directions

Materials:

- dark brown felt • white felt • yellow felt • black felt
- white embroidery floss • brown embroidery floss • stuffing

1) Cut two toast shapes out of dark brown felt, one inside toast piece out of white, butter out of yellow, two arms and two legs out of dark brown felt, eyes and mouth out of black, and cut some random butter swooshes out of white.

2) With brown embroidery floss, stitch arms and legs to the top of the bottom piece of toast (get it? You want them sandwiched (ha!) between both pieces of toast at the end).

3) With white embroidery floss, stitch the white inside toast piece to the top of the top piece of toast. Just go right around the edges. Then stitch the yellow butter to the white piece. On top of that, stitch your white butter swooshes. Finally, stitch your eyes and mouth (and nose, if you want) to the very top. Use the white embroidery floss to stitch a little eyeball inside the black felt eye circles.

4) Now let's put Mr. Toast Man together! Put bottom toast piece underneath top toast piece. We're not turning him inside out so his good sides should be out with his limbs sticking out from the middle. Take your brown embroidery floss and whipstitch around the edges of your toast. Just before you finish, stop and stuff Mr. Toast Man. Then stitch the hole closed.



Mr. Toast Man is now ready for play!

- Other ideas:
- You also leave his limbs off for fun felt play food.
 - Instead of yellow butter, use red felt for jam.

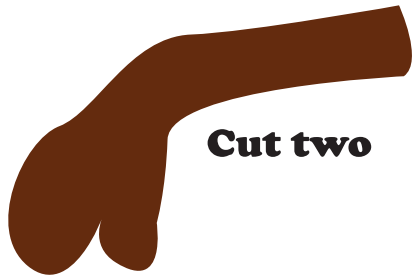
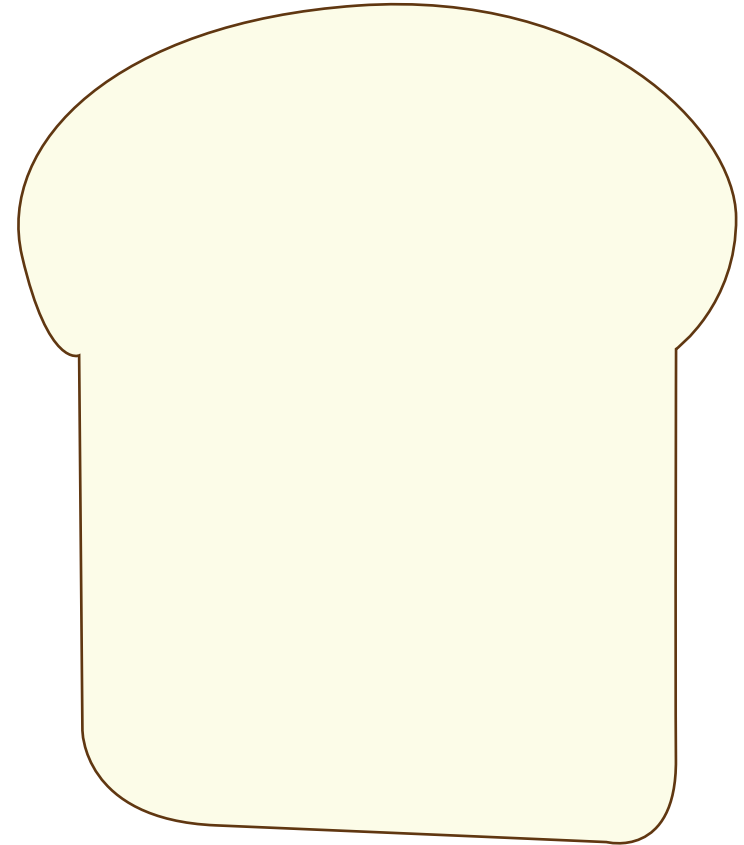
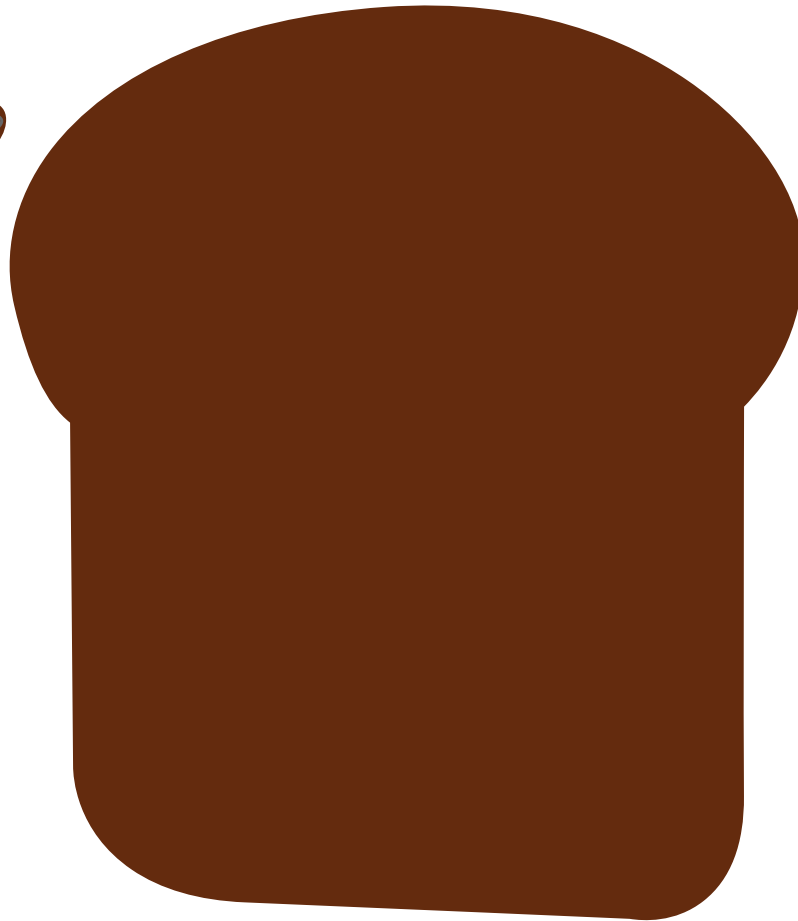
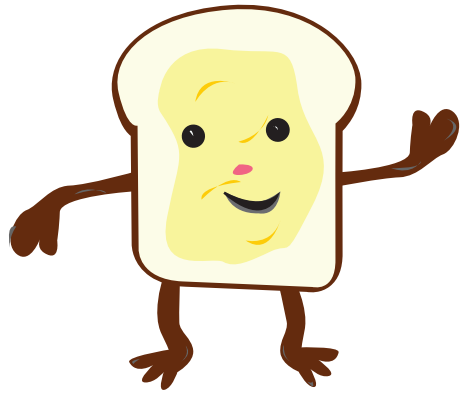

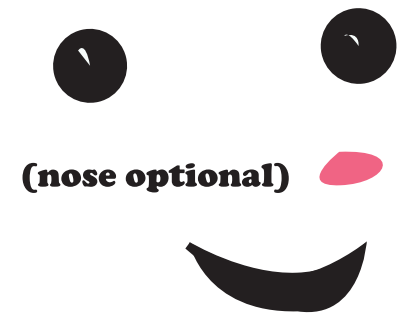
Cut assorted swooshy
